- e. Survey firm shall not pour, bury burn, not in any way dispose of a chemical on the work job site. No open burning, debris, or rubbish will be permitted at the project site.

The cost of all safety measures mentioned above and any other internationally practiced measures shall not be quoted separately but will be deemed covered in the quoted price. A breach to any of the safety measures can lead to the termination of contract.

6. DELIVERABLES:

- a) Classified turning movement count at specified locations. If required, additional points shall be conveyed as per design requirements
- b) Classified Turning movement count at access points of proposed direct and feeder service routes.
- c) Pedestrian movement count at specified locations
- d) Parking survey at specified locations. If required additional points shall be finalized as per design requirement.
- e) Comprehensive report including critical movement analysis and recommendations.
- f) Counts' raw data in excel format based on the Client's approved samples.
- g) Output files data in excel format based on the Clients approved samples.
- h) Video recording of each location for 01 hour during each peak hour (AM and PM)
- i) The survey report to include the traffic analysis with the applied methodology and validation process. It shall also include photographs of each survey sites with longitudes and latitudes information displayed on small map. The survey activities; such as installation of counters and cameras to also be photographed and included in the report for each site. In addition the specifications of the used equipment shall be stated in the submitted report.
- j) Traffic survey formats and outputs in excel, and drawings showing locations and configuration of the sites to be surveyed.

In case of any errors observed in survey data, the selected firm shall revise the particular portion of the work at no additional cost and shall provide revised data as above.

7. TIME FOR COMPLETION:

The whole survey work shall be completed in all respects within a period of twenty-Eight (28) days from the date of letter of acceptance/ award. Traffic survey report can be submitted up to two weeks (14 days) after the completion of survey work.

8. PAYMENT:

- a. The quoted bid shall be inclusive of all taxes, including but not limited to Income Tax and Sales Tax.
- b. To obtain first-hand information on the Assignment and on the local conditions, you are encouraged to pay a visit to the subject site before submitting a proposal. **You must fully inform yourself of local conditions and take them into account in preparing your proposal.** No financial claim whatsoever, shall be entertained if the work is suffered due to local conditions and law and order situation.

- c. Please note that:
 - i. The cost of preparing the proposal and of negotiating the contract, including a visit to the subject site, are not reimbursable as a direct cost of the Assignment; and
 - ii. NESPAK is not bound to accept any of the Proposals submitted and reserves the right to annul the selection process at any time prior to Contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the Applicant/ Firm.
- d. 25% Mobilization Advance
- e. Remaining 75% payment shall be made on Completion of actual work and successful review of the Deliverables and subject to payment of the work by the Client (Sindh Mass Transit Authority (SMTA) to NESPAK.
- f. No payment shall be made for incomplete work.

9. TERMS OF CONDITIONS:

The Survey firm to provide the Client with samples for:

- a. The survey firm not to carry out any survey works until the Client confirm the survey dates.
- b. The Survey firm to obtain all related permissions from concerned authorities to carry out the surveys without any delays to the approved survey dates.
- c. The Survey firm to repeat, upon review of the Client, any survey locations missing, incomplete, unrealistic counts and in case of the accuracy of the result at any location is less than 90%.
